- As we commemorate the 43rd anniversary of the 1978 adoption of the Buenos Aires Plan of Action, we stand once again in solidarity, recognizing our achievements and challenges, reiterating our commitment with South-South Cooperation.
- As a South-South Cooperation offeror, Colombia is promoting economic reactivation initiatives with its partners, working tirelessly towards a more inclusive, resilient and sustainable recovery of our region and beyond from the devastating effects of the Covid-19 pandemic.
